Race Day Volunteer Positions

<u>Weekly Commitment</u>	<u>Description/Time of Day (times are estimates; weather and ski conditions will dictate)</u>
1-2 hours	Course Setter – Helps Race Director set up the Race course before the Races from 8:15-10:00. Training and refreshments are provided. (On-course/Skiing Position)
3-4 hours	Starter (top of Course) - Helps the Asst. Race Director set up timing equipment and start Racers during Races from 9:00am-1:00pm. Training and refreshments are provided. (On-course/Skiing Position)
3-4 hours	Timer (bottom of Course) – Helps the Asst. Race Director set up timing equipment, monitor and note Skier times during Races from 9:00am-1:00pm. Training and refreshments are provided. (On-course/Skiing Position)
3-4 hours	Time Recorders – enter Racer's official times into spreadsheets for posting (Excel skills desirable) from 12:00-2:00pm. (Lodge/Non-Ski Position)
1-2 hours	Skier Check-In – Sign in Skiers, Volunteers in from 8:00-8:30 am. (Lodge/Non-Ski Position)
1/2-1 hour	Skier Check-Out – Sign out Skiers, Volunteers at 3:15 pm. (Lodge/Non-Ski Position)
2-3 hours (am/pm)	Lodge Radio Minder – Sign in & out radios to Coaches/Volunteers. Sign out 8:00-9:00 am; sign-in 3:00-3:15pm. (Lodge/Non-Ski Position)
3-4 hours	Gatekeeper – Assist Race Director with monitoring gates during Races (10:00-1:00 pm). Training and refreshments are provided. (On-course/Skiing Position).
2 hours	BWYSL Merchandise & Lift Ticket Sales – sell daily lift tickets to non-pass holders, t-shirts, sweatshirts, in Lodge on Race mornings between 8:00-10:00am. (Lodge/Non-Ski Position)
All day	Lodge Parent – Point person for Skiers who are cold, tired and resting in the Lodge. Also keeps radio contact with Coaches sending Skiers or messages to the Lodge. (Lodge/Non-Ski Position)

Ongoing Non-Daily Volunteer Opportunities

Not everybody can make it to the slopes to volunteer regularly. We have opportunities that do not require you to be at Sierra-At-Tahoe on your child's Race days. Some opportunities require a couple of hours per week, while others are event-oriented and will require planning. All positions are supported by, and assistance will be provided by the Board.

<u>Weekly Commitment</u>	<u>Description</u>
1-2 hours	Weekly Memo/Newsletter Editor – you will put together the weekly Parent/Skier memos. Information, notices and input from the Board will be provided to you on a weekly basis.
1 hour	Web Site Chair – you will maintain BWYSL's web site, and update it weekly or as needed with submissions approved by the President.
1 hour	Advertising Chair – you will get BWYSL news into the local newspapers. Race results, etc. will be submitted on a weekly basis.
1 hour	Sponsorship Chair – you will work with the Board to contact our previous and potential sponsors on a weekly basis, or as needed, to insure that they are informed of BWYSL events. You will also follow-up on pledges from these sponsors with assistance from the Board.
5 hours	Awards Banquet Chair – You will head up our annual Awards Banquet. Many volunteers are needed to ensure the success of the Banquet. The Banquet will be held in late March 2011 at Sierra at Tahoe.
Season	Bib Keeper – Keeps bibs, sorts, organizes, assigns and tracks down missing bibs throughout the Season.
